The above filly is medium sized and very sharp and athletic. She is likely to be an early- to- mid-season two year old. The family is all speed so she will, most likely start, over 5 or 6 furlongs. She was entered for the sales as she is an ideal sales filly looking like an early two year old but cut her head and had to be withdrawn. She is working very well at home.

Bahamian Bounty was the third top rated two year old in Europe over 5-6 furlongs, winning the Middle Park Stakes Group1. He retired to stud in 1998 and has sired the winners of 659 races value 6.55 million. He is the sire of Pastoral Pursuits winner of the July cup. His sire, Cadeaux Genereux, was the Champion 3 year old sprinter in Europe and the Champion older sprinter in Europe. He won seven races over 5 -7 furlongs including the July cup Group 1 and the sprint Championship Group 1.

Royal Applause was the Champion older Sprinter in Europe 1997. He won nine races including the Middle Park Stakes Gr 1 and the Haydock Sprint Cup Gr1. He retired to stud in 1998 and has sired the winners of 1051 races valued over £14 million. He is a champion sire of two year olds and the sire of the champion 1st season sire Acclamation. He is also the sire of Peak to Creek who won seven races at two and £193k including the Horris Hill Stakes, Gr 3. Peek to Creek is the half brother of See You Later, the dam of Perfect Cover.

Perfect Cover is out of the Listed winner, See You Later out of Rivers Rhapsody. She is a half -sister to the Listed winner, Aahayson, and to Thebes, Take Ten and Annatalia. Between them they were sold for over £850k as yearlings and have won over £400k in prize money. The 2009 half-brother by Teofilo was sold for £220,000 last year.

Comments from the independent valuer. *"She is a three parts sister in blood to Take Ten (210,000 gns yearling, Timeform 106 won four races at two and three worth over £200k. She is also closely related to Thebes (TFR 105). Dam a half- sister to Listed winner Aahayson. She is from the exceptionally fast family of Peak to Creek, Ripples Maid and Lesson in Humidity."* Value £20,000

Cost of a 1/8th share to include training fees

Year 1 £5,500 payable as £4,000 on agreement to purchase and £1,500 on the 1st May 2012.
