The above filly is strong, attractive and athletic. She was in training for a period last year but was not sufficiently mature to run. She is be trained by Ralph Beckett at Kimpton Down, near Andover who thinks she will have no problem winning races next year. He was selected as he has a good track record with home bred fillies. The family is all speed so she will most likely run over 5 or 6 furlongs.

Her sire, Kyllachy is the highest rated son of Pivotal at stud. He was the 2002 Champion European older sprinter winning the Gr1 Nunthorpe Stakes and the Gr2 Temple Stakes. He retired to stud in 2003 and has sired the winners of 476 races and £5.5m. He was the UK Champion 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> crop sire and is the sire of Gr2 winner, Arabian Gleam and the 2010 Listed winner, Mabait, both out of Danzig line mares in common with Perfect Cover. Furthermore, his dam was by Song who is from the same sire line as Thebes and Take Ten both half brothers of Perfect Cover.

Perfect Cover is by Royal Applause. He was the 1997 Champion older Sprinter in Europe. He won 9 races including the Gr1 Middle Park Stakes and the Gr1 Haydock Sprint Cup. He retired to stud in 1998 and has sired the winners of 1051 races valued over £14m. He is a champion sire of 2 year olds and the sire of the champion 1<sup>st</sup> season sire Acclamation. He is also the sire of Peak to Creek who won 7 races at 2 and £193k including the Gr3 Horris Hill Stakes, and is the half brother of See You Later, the dam of Perfect Cover. Perfect Cover is therefore 75% related to Peak to Creek.

Perfect Cover was purchased as a yearling but failed to perform to her potential due to joint problems caused by over feeding as a foal but is impeccably bred being out of the Listed winner, See You Later out of Rivers Rhapsody. Perfect Cover is a half sister to the Listed winner Aahayson, Thebes, Take Ten and Annatalia. Between them they cost over £850k as yearlings but confidence in the family has been rewarded as so far they have won over £400k in prize money.
